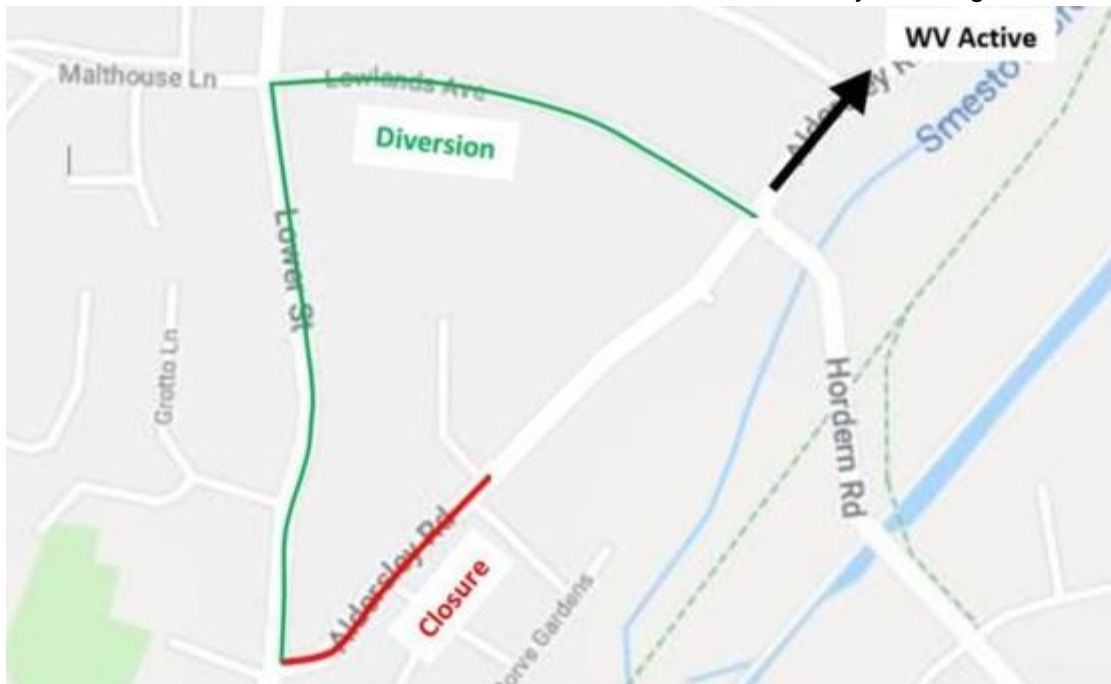
ROAD CLOSURE (BIT OF ALDERSLEY ROAD)

Please note the following item which is direct from Aldersley - however Aldersley is open and will be accessible from Aldersley Road UNDER THE BRIDGE end - plus from the Hordern Road TRAFFIC LIGHTS (black arrow) - as well as the re-direction from the Tettenhall Road as shown in green below.

Road closure affecting access to Aldersley

Access to WV Active Aldersley via Aldersley Road will be restricted from Monday 6 May - Friday 7 June 2019. This is due to a temporary road closure to renew the water main in the area.

WV Active customers will still be able to access the centre from this direction by following the below diversion.



Aldersley Road will be closed in both directions from Lower Street to Crane Terrace. Customers are advised to follow the diversion via Lower Street and Lowlands Avenue which leads to back Aldersley Road. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and hope to see you at Aldersley soon.

Be prepared for an Umpire check on court at the Warning Hooter at 6.55p.m. including teams not playing in the first round.

Matches are **5 minutes each way no half-time** - please change ends smartly and umpires will restart.

There will only be 3 minutes between so please move off the court immediately - and onto your next court (if playing) immediately. Points will be a simple 2 for a win, 1 if a draw and 0 if a loss.
